

DAY 1: REIMS, STRASBOURG AND ITS CHRISTMAS MARKET

MORNING

- On the way to Alsace, uncover the treasures of Reims.
 Architectural masterpiece or light tingling champagne bubbles, what's your pick?
- Over lunch, meet Jean, a glass blower. He'll blow you away with his red-hot talent and bubbling joyful temper!

AFTERNOON

- Strasbourg by night stroll in the light-studded historical city: the "Petite France", the Cathedral... and of course the wonder associated with the oldest traditional Christmas market in France!
- For dinner, you'll discover the abundant generosity of local cuisine.
- Spend the night in a typical and quaint guest house.



AVAILABLE OPTIONS

Extend the stay in the area for one day

- Visit a prestigious cellar in Reims or Épernay, for instance: Moët & Chandon and Dom Pérignon or Pommery or Mercier) and sample their champagne.
- Meet a small independant champagne producer in his family's compound.
- The Crystal Museum will enthrall you, especially while talking with Master Glassmakers at the Cristallerie.
- Strasbourg on wheels: ride bicycles to get around the city, the only in France to have as many bike lanes and bike fans!

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DAY 2: COLMAR AND THE HAUT-KOENIGSBOURG CASTLE

MORNING

- Gertwiller is the hometown of gingerbread. Taste the magic of Christmas in a museum that will, for sure, bring back childhood memories. Michel, the owner, will let you peek around the workshop where he bakes and makes his creations.
- Get to know Alain, an independent vintner who will walk you through the steps and secrets of wine-making and let you taste the wines he creates from the grapes of his vineyard.
- Together with the wines, you'll be treated to a platter of local delicatessen as a host of the family.

AFTERNOON

- Reach the towering Haut-Koenigsburg medieval fort, built at an altitude of 757 meters (nearly 2,500 feet).
 Marvel at the landscape and scenery as you take in all of the Alsace plains.
- Find that perfect gift for your loved one in the Colmar Christmas market, bustling with joy and a definite touch of fairy-like dreams.
- Savor typical and delicious meals from local produce.
- Spend a restful night in a heart-warming guesthouse.

- Wonderful Colmar by night in a small boat.
- Meet Pierre and Jean, two innovative vintners who produce exceptional wine using techniques inspired by biodynamics. Their house and facilities are energy passive and storage is environment-friendly. Taste their original and subtle creations.
- Learn about tradition life in Alsace in France's largest open-air museum. Meet talented smithies and visit their workshops: blacksmith, barrel maker, wickerworker, cobbler, barber, baker, wheelwright, potter, saddler.

DAY 3: EGUISHEIM AND MUNSTER

MORNING

- In Eguisheim, you'll find one of the most authentic Alsace Christmas markets set in one of the most beautiful villages of France! Meet its artisans and local producers.
- Follow the 5-Castle-Road and reach Munster, a tiny Alsace village nestled at the heart of the Vosges mountain range.
- Lunch in a farm on home-made cheese, cold meat delicatessen and home-baked bread.

AFTERNOON

- Willy, master pastry chef, will teach you to weave and bake your very own pretzels!
- Dinner and an evening stroll in the magnificent historical downtown Troyes center, with its colorful wood-beam houses and the magnificent stained glass windows of the cathedral.
