- <u>DAY 1: Vézelay Guédelon</u>
- DAY 2: Beaune and Flavigny-sur-Ozerain
- DAY 3: Dijon

DAY 1: VÉZELAY - GUÉDELON

MORNING

- Claudette, a woman vintner in Vézelay, will share with you her life's passion: wine.
- Lunch in Claudette's vineyard.
- Visit the Vézelay roman-style basilica, where pilgrims heading for Santiago de Compostela gather to start off.

AFTERNOON

- Marvel at the castle-in-the-building of Guédelon, a castle constructed with the exact same tools and techniques as were used in the Middle Ages.
- Spend the night in an ancient Cistercian abbey with a rich past. Both Coco Chanel and the Duke of Westminster have also lodged there.



AVAILABLE OPTIONS

Extend the stay in the area for one day

- Stopover in Pontigny Abbey, the largest abbey in the world, founded in 1114. It used to house monks of the Cistercian order.
- Take a stroll in the quaint town of Chablis, visit its wine cellars and taste a few bottles of its local production.
- Walk a portion of the Santiago de Compostela pilgrim's trail.
- Spend a moment in Noyers-sur-Serein, a medieval village honored by the "Most beautiful village of France" award, and savor some of its wines that are the pride of Burgundy.
- Meet a goat cheese producer and visit his farm and facilities.

DAY 2: BEAUNE AND FLAVIGNY-SUR-OZERAIN

MORNING

- Visit the Beaune Hospice, a flamboyant gothic-style hospital founded in the Xvth century by the Chancellor of the Dukes of Burgundy.
- In the midst of famed vineyards, discover the Clos de Vougeot castle, where the iconic "Tastevins Brotherhood" gathers to further the lineage of Burgundy wines.
- Open your heart to the village of Flavigny-sur-Ozerain, awardee of the "Most beautiful Village of France" title, where Johnny Depp and Juliette Binoche filmed the movie "Chocolat" in the year 2000.
- An inn run by wives of local producers will prepare a delicious lunch for you.

AFTERNOON

- Visit a candy factory. Inside a Benedictine Abbey of old, anis-flavored sugar sweets are produced, and the secrets of this natural product will be unveiled for you.
- Dine and sleep in an exceptional residence.



AVAILABLE OPTIONS

Extend the stay in the area for one day

- Awe and wonder await you at the Fontenay Abbey, the most ancient fully preserved Cistercian abbey.
- Meet actual monks at the Cîteaux abbey, which is a Cistercian abbey still active to this day.
- Meet the Pelletier family in their castle and vineyard in Prémeaux.
- Experience novelty at the Pommard Castle, a vineyard exploring biodynamic agriculture to produce prestigious local wines while respecting the environment.
- Help a goat cheese producer to milk his goats.

DAY 3: DIJON

MORNING

- Tour the Fallot Mustard factory, a family business founded in 1840 that still caters to the most prestigious customers today. It is famous for the quality of its work and produce.
- Visit a surprising snail farm in a small Burgundy village, and chat with the producer who will surely share his passion with you.
- Dine in a restaurant.

AFTERNOON

- Meet a wine maker who will let you taste his best wines in his cellar as he details the production steps that make Bourgogne vintage wines stand out.
- Discover Stéphanie and Christophe and their artisan cheese, and taste them as they share their adventures in cheese-making.
- Dine and sleep in an exceptional residence.
