DAY 1: REIMS AND CHAMPAGNE CELLARS

MORNING

- Visit a prestigious cellar in Reims or Épernay, for instance: Moët & Chandon and Dom Pérignon or Pommery or Mercier) and sample their champagne.
- Tour the vineyards and have the production process explained to you in full.
- Local specialty cuisine awaits you for lunch in a nearby restaurant.

AFTERNOON

- Meet Florence and her family, 3rd generation independent vintners, pioneering organic champagne.
- Visit their homely cellar and taste their exceptional champagne.
- Meander the streets of Hautvillers village, and visit the VIIth century Saint Peter's Abbey where Dom Pérignon, the monk who invented champagne, is buried.
- Dine and spend the night in a charming and traditional guesthouse.



AVAILABLE OPTIONS

Extend the stay in the area for one day

- Marvel at the intricate details of the Notre-Dame cathedral in Reims, where 33 Kings of France were crowned.
- All your senses will be tested during the Mumm cellar visit. A guided tour for our small group only sets the pitch for the tasting of their exceptional Grand Cru vintage wines, Blanc de Blancs and Blanc de Noirs.
- An in-house oenologist in the Moët & Chandon cellars will tour you around and guide you in the intricacies of wine-tasting with Vintage years of white and rosé wines.

DAY 2: FRENCH CUISINE DISCOVERY DAY IN THE CHAMPAGNE REGION

MORNING

- Friendly jostle in the Epernay farmer's market where you can meet and talk with local producers (vegetable growers, cheese makers, bakers...).
- Meet Catherine and Pascal, a couple raising cows and chickens out in the open.
- Visit their farm and sample their home-made products: pâté flavored with either cognac or champagne grape marc, meat pies, coq-au-vin..

- Lunch on such farmer's produce.

AFTERNOON

- Get to know a small, independant champagne producer who earned the "Environment-friendly production" label thanks to his struggle to protect biodiversity.
- Taste and sample his extraordinary champagne, truly an excellent value for the price.
- Dine and savor the night in a charming and traditional guesthouse.



AVAILABLE OPTIONS

Extend the stay in the area for one day

- Meet a chocolate-maker in his workshop and learn to cook and prepare your own.
- Nature walk in a family farm where you can pick all sorts of fruits and vegetables (strawberries, apples, tomatoes...) without any doubts as to quality since they respect the environment in all their practices.
- Share with local apple orchard managers and taste their very own apple juice. They'll happily share both passion and know-how.
- Meet Anthony in his vegetable patch and discover his home-made jellys and jams.
- Learn French Cuisine in Reims.


DAY 3: ÉPERNAY AND VERZENAY

MORNING

- Visit a prestigious cellar in Épernay or Reims (for instance: Veuve Clicquot, Mumm, Perrier, Ruinart, Heidsieck...) and sample their vintage champagne wines.
- Stroll along the luxurious Avenue de Champagne, with XVIIIth century townhouses and learn about how champagne wine is produced.
- Lunch in Verzenay, with the option to taste local produce.

AFTERNOON

- Breathtaking view from the top of Verzenay lighthouse with vineyards stretching to the horizon.
- Key knowledge about what makes a wine great can be sought at the Vineyard Museum, which even has a tasting session for various champagnes.

- Hot-air balloon: incredible view of the vineyards in the rolling hills of the Champagne region.
- Bike ride along trails that serpent through famous vineyards.
- Create your own champagne: with a talented sommelier, create your own champagne mix.
