Discover Normandy

Suggested itinerary for 4 days in Normandy. Departures depend on the availability of producers and artisans

DAY 1: GIVERNY - HONFLEUR

MORNING

- Peek into the life of Claude Monet, the painter who invented Impressionism, beating the cobblestones in Giverny, his hometown.
- Enter the house he lived in and meet the muses of his inspiration: fabulous rare flower gardens and a certain famous pond... waterlilies included!
- Lunch in "eat local" mode with fresh produce grown nearby.

AFTERNOON

- Take a walk in historical downtown Honfleur, complete with its century-old fishport.

- Meet Agathe as she toils away in her cider brewery.
 She'll certainly spark your interest as she shares her passion and a few tantalizing tastes of her prize bottles.
 You'll learn all about distillation and aging of strong Calvados apple spirits and the secrets to fermenting apple cider.
- After that, a (perhaps light-headed) walk through her organic apple orchards ought to clear the mind.
- Local specialty cuisine awaits you for dinner in a nearby restaurant.
- Sleep the night away in a typical and welcoming historical house.

AVAILABLE OPTIONS

- Meet up with Patrick, cheesemaker in the town of Camembert. This village is where the world-famous cheese comes from. And why not discover a few other famous places, such as Livarot and Pontl'Évêque?
- Meditate in awe and wonder in the largest wood-built church of all France: Sainte-Catherine in Honfleur.
- Visit Honfleur by night only illuminated with fire torches!
- Carole, a distinguished wine-taster in Deauville, will gladly impart her knowledge of the art as you sample a few of her trophy wines.
- Mingle with the Elite of French society at the horse-races of Deauville, and perhaps lodge a bet on one or the other stallion.
- Follow in the footsteps of famous movie actors and actresses when they took to the stage in Deauville.
 Marion Cotillard, Catherine Deneuve made their debuts here, but these French actresses also shared the local spotlight with several others from across the pond... Clint Eastwood and Tom Hanks, among many more!
- Savor fresh seafood prepared with utmost gastronomical standards directly within the fisherman's abode.



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DAY 2: GREAT GASTRONOMICAL TOUR OF GRANDCAMP-MAISY, ASNIÈRES-EN-BESSIN AND ARROMANCHES

MORNING

- Stroll along a typical farmer's market of the Normandy coast. Chat up growers, cheesemakers, fishmongers, butchers... as they boast how delicious their produce is.
- Learn French Cuisine with Carl, a renowned Chef. With his guidance, fill pots and pans with the morning market's fresh goods for a delicious self-made gastronomical lunch!

AFTERNOON

 Whip up a conversation with Barbara, a young farmer who produces her own cheese, cream and butter. Pat her Normandy-bred cows between the eyes and you'll understand why their milk and cheese are sought after across the planet!

- An unusual meeting with Victor who is passionate about snails! He'll quickly convert you to this tasty culinary oddity in his surprising Bessin farm. / only from May 15th to September 15th, reservation required.
- Free time if needed, or guided tour of Bayeux. This town casually flaunts its IXth century cathedral bedecked with a tapestry woven in 1066 by William the Conqueror's own wife!
- Dine on delicious crêpes and galettes, a staple Normandy meal, in a nearby Crêperie.
- Spend a night "à la française" in a historical monument, a XVIIth century castle.

AVAILABLE OPTIONS

- Discover Benjamin's work as he manages his apple orchard in Normandy. He produces limited edition cider, pommeau and calvados spirits. He'll gladly walk you around his workshop and you'll get to taste his all-natural products.
- Sweet-tooth? Step inside a candy factory! Visiting this workshop will show you the ins and outs of baking caramel sweets.
- Meet a young couple managing an oyster farm as they battle to preserve the environment and their ecosystem. Visit the oyster breeding grounds at low tide.
- Set foot in the workshop of a pottery maker, located in a XIXth century manor. This artisan was granted the "Entreprise du Patrimoine Vivant" label, which roughly translates into "Living Heirloom Enterprise".
- Discover a chocolate maker's kitchen and taste different types of chocolates.
- Visit a permaculture farm and understand the techniques. Your own vegetable patch back home will surely get an upgrade!
- Savor the passing of time during a literal field trip through the French countryside... and savor sweet ripe strawberries straight from the bush, in season!



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DAY 3: D-DAY BEACH MEMORIALS: US PILGRIMAGE

MORNING

- Set foot on Hoc Point, where bunkers and cliff overhangs were stormed by American Rangers on June 6th, 1944.
- Trudge along Omaha Beach where 34 000 soldiers made landfall on D-Dav.
- Lunch in a beachside canteen with delicious local specialties.

AFTERNOON

- Honor 9000 fallen soldiers in the American Cemetery. with rank upon rank of white tombstones aligned and overlooking the ocean.
- Discover Arromanches and what's left of the artificial port made from scratch by our British allies.
- D-day as if you were there: a 360° movie experience that hurls you back in the past.
- Spend the night in either a castle or a magnificent townhouse, and learn the local lore as the owners share precious moments with you.

AVAILABLE OPTIONS

- Face-to-face talk with a World War Il war veteran who, at the time, was 20 years old.
- Discover Utah Beach and the Sainte-Mère-Église village where parachute trooper John Steel stayed stuck for an entire night on the church steeple during D-Day.
- Embark on a fishing pilothouse boat to view D-Day beaches from the sea.
- Honor fallen soldiers in nearby military cemeteries.
- Visit the World War II memorial in Caen.
- Have a stopover in Dieppe, where, in 1942, a first Allied landing failed to hold.
- Explore Bayeux, a city with a XIth century cathedral. Discover the famous ancient tapestry woven in 1066 by Queen Mathilde, William the Conqueror's wife!
- Reflect on the written word as you visit the Ardenne Abbey and uncover the past in the Institute for Contemporary Publishing Archives in Saint-Germain-la-Blanche-Herbe.





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DAY 3: D-DAY BEACH MEMORIALS: CANADIAN PILGRIMAGE

MORNING

- Juno Beach at Bernières-sur-Mer is where the Canadian Infantry disembarked in the early morning of June 6th, under the command of Officer Rodney Keller.
- Visit the Juno Beach Center (at Courseulles-sur-Mer), where you'll learn all about how vital Canada's actions were during World War II.
- Lunch in a restaurant that boasts delicious local meals

AFTERNOON

- Visit Hoc Point and what remains of its bunkers.
- Thank the fallen soldiers at the 2000-tomb Canadian Cemetery at Bény-sur-Mer in Reviers.
- Spend the night in either a castle or a magnificent townhouse, and learn the local lore as the owners share precious moments with you.



AVAILABLE OPTIONS

- Face-to-face talk with a World War II war veteran who, at the time, was 20 years old.

- Get to know Emmanuel, a bubbly shopowner cracking joke upon joke as he mans his shop on the cobblestone Grand Rue at the heart of Mont-Saint-Michel. He'll tell you all about his family's arrival on the Mount... in 1680!
- Spend a memorable night in a quaint hotel directly located on Mont-Saint-Michel.

- Ride like the wind during a horseback outing across the bay at low tide.
- Visit Paul, a fourth-generation apple cider and calvados producer, and taste his exquisite produce.
- Discover how an independent jeweler works and visit his workshop.
- Spend some relaxing family time at a traditional wind mill. Milling from wheat to flour and bread won't have any secrets from you anymore!
- Cross the Mont-Saint-Michel bay on foot with a qualified guide.
- Meet local producers in a nearby village market.
