A city transcending its past

- With your guide, hop aboard a cute street train to visit the towering "Notre Dame de la Garde" basilica, the "Good Mother". From there, 360° panorama of Marseille.
- The Marseille chocolate delicacies won't have any secrets for you after an insider's peek inside a chocolate maker's workshop... where you're in for a surprising treat over lunch!

AFTERNOON

- Let our knowledgeable guide walk you through the winding streets of historic Marseille, culminating with the stunning modern architecture along the seawall.
- Meet engaging craftsmen, enter their workshops and learn to handle some of their tools. Possibilities abound: Gaëlle will show you how to make coral jewelry, while others share tips on how to make clay nativity figures, knives, traditional soaps...

- Let a master guide walk you through its fortified church and its vicinity.
- Free time in the village. Swimming possible at the nearby beach.
- Dining in a restaurant of your choice in Aix, selected from one of our best recommendations.
- Spend the night at the hotel in Aix-en-Provence.

STAY SAFE WITH FINDING FRANCE

The health and safety of our guests is of utmost importance to us.

Our private tours are designed to preserve your social bubble against Covid-19. We usually allow a maximum of 8 people per tour.

We implement all the safety measures to protect you against Covid-19: daily disinfection of the vehicle with a virucidal agent, face masks and hydro-alcoholic gel provided everyday whenever requested.

Once you are in France, we pick you up at your doorstep and drop you off at the location of your choice.

Physical contact is limited to the strict minimum.

Workshops and meet-ups are organized exclusively for you and your group. Given the constant evolution of the epidemic, we recommend all our guests to review their local authorities travel guidance and health advisories related to this outbreak.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

For all tours, a reservation will be confirmed only after payment by the customer of a tour deposit equivalent to at least 30% of the total amount of the trip.

CANCELLATION POLICY:

Tour deposit is 100% refundable from date of booking until 6 months before tour departure date.

6 months to 61 days prior to departure: Traveler forfeits 30% of the total amount of the trip

60-31 days prior to departure: Traveler forfeits 50% of the total amount of the trip

30 days prior to departure or less: Traveler forfeits 100% of the total amount of the trip

No cancellation penalty when funds are put on hold towards a future trip. No-Show or cancellations received on tour departure day: traveller forfeits 100% of tour monies paid.

You may change from one trip to another before trip departure without any penalty, as long as space is available during the tour dates requested. Finding France must be notified of intent to switch no later than 90 days before booked tour departure date.

If canceled due to travel bans declared by the French government and by foreign governments relating to Covid-19, Finding France will deliver by email or by mail a voucher valid for 18 months from its issue and corresponding exactly to the amount of the initial service; The voucher can be used for the same service or another, in part or in whole.
