
Burgundy

Burgundy - Wine and Castle

DAY 1

MORNING

- Claudette, a woman vintner in Vézelay, will share with you her life's passion: wine.
- If you want, we can have lunch in Claudette's vineyard.
- Visit the Vézelay roman-style basilica, where pilgrims heading for Santiago de Compostela gather to start off.

AFTERNOON

- Marvel at the castle-in-the-building of Guédelon, a castle constructed with the exact same tools and techniques as were used in the Middle Ages.



AVAILABLE OPTIONS* Instead of the suggested activities in the main itinerary

- Stopover in Pontigny Abbey, the largest abbey in the world, founded in 1114. It used to house monks of the Cistercian order.
- Take a stroll in the quaint town of Chablis, visit its wine cellars and taste a few bottles of its local production.
- Meet a goat cheese producer and visit his farm and facilities.



Beaune/Flavigny-sur-Ozerain

DAY 2

MORNING

- Visit the Beaune Hospice, a gothic-style hospital founded in the Xvth century by the Chancellor of the Dukes of Burgundy.
- In the midst of famed vineyards, discover the Clos de Vougeot castle, where the iconic "Tastevins Brotherhood" gathers to further the lineage of Burgundy wines.
- Open your heart to the village of Flavigny-sur-Ozerain, one of the "Most beautiful Village of France", where Johnny Depp and Juliette Binoche filmed the movie "Chocolat".

AFTERNOON

- Visit a candy factory. Inside a Benedictine Abbey of old, anis-flavored sugar sweets are produced, and the secrets of this natural product will be unveiled for you.

- Awe and wonder await you at the Fontenay Abbey, the most ancient fully preserved Cistercian abbey.
- Experience novelty at the Pommard Castle, a vineyard exploring biodynamic agriculture to produce prestigious local wines while respecting the environment
- Help a goat cheese producer to milk his goats.





MORNING

- Tour the Fallot Mustard factory, a family business founded in 1840 that still caters to the most prestigious customers today. It is famous for the quality of its work and produce.
- Visit a surprising snail farm in a small Burgundy village, and chat with the producer who will surely share his passion with you.

AFTERNOON

- Meet a wine maker who will let you taste his best wines in his cellar as he details the production steps that make Bourgogne vintage wines stand out.
- Discover Stéphanie and Christophe and their artisan cheese, and taste them as they share their adventures in cheese-making.

- Taste the best wines of Burgundy at the Cité Internationale de la Gastronomie et du Vin.
- 600 oak barrels await your visit in the cellars of the Villars Fontaine Castle, near Nuits-Saint-Georges. Understand how exceptional wines are produced, from grape to bottle.
