

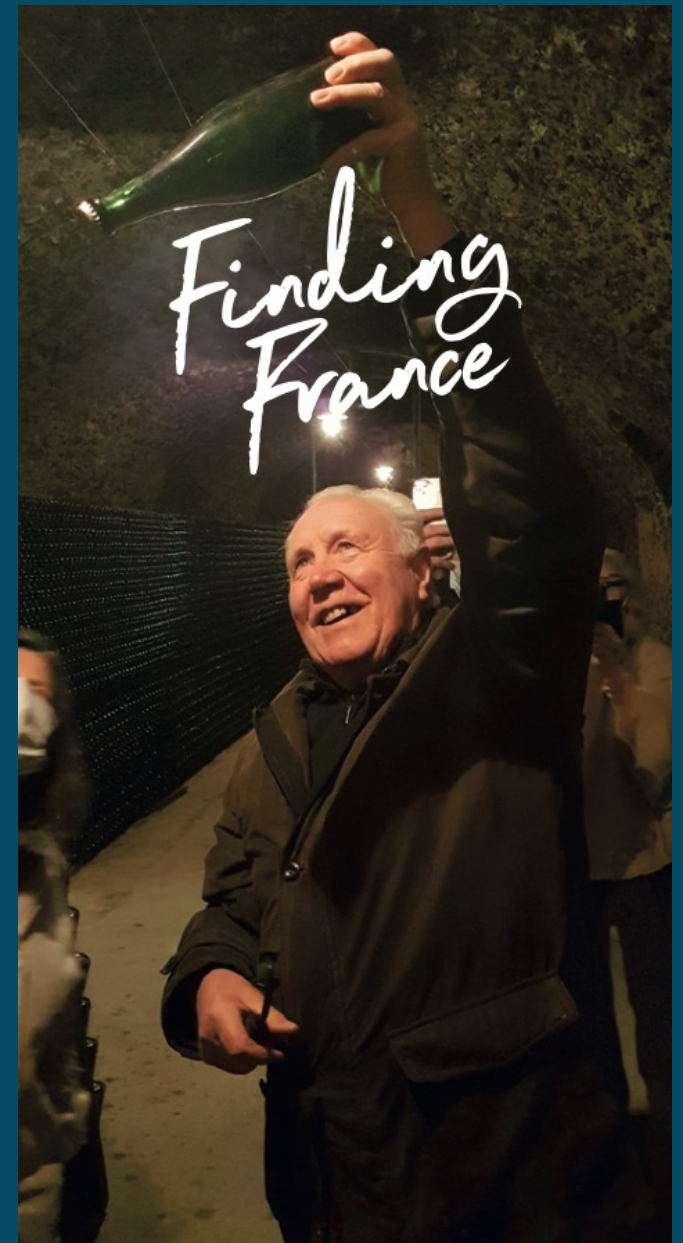
# Champagne

# Champagne cellars in Épernay or Reims

## DAY 1

### MORNING

- Visit a prestigious cellar in Reims or Épernay, such as: Moët & Chandon and Dom Pérignon, Taittinger, Veuve Clicquot, Ruinard...
- Taste their champagne.
  
- Tour the vineyards and have the production process explained to you in full.

### AFTERNOON

- Discover a family owned cellar.
  
- Meet the producer at his home and taste his exceptional Champagne.



### AVAILABLE OPTIONS\*

- Marvel at the intricate details of the Notre-Dame cathedral in Reims, where 33 Kings of France were crowned.
  
- Meander the streets of Hautvillers village, and visit the 11th century Saint Peter's Abbey where Dom Pérignon, the monk who invented champagne, is buried.

# French cuisine discovery in Champagne area

## DAY 2

### MORNING

- Friendly jostle in the Epernay farmer's market where you can meet and talk with local producers (vegetable growers, cheese makers, bakers...).
- Visit their farm and sample their home-made products: pâté flavored with either cognac or champagne grape marc, meat pies, coq-au-vin.

### AFTERNOON

- Get to know a small, independent champagne producer who earned the "Environment-friendly production" label thanks to his struggle to protect biodiversity.
- Taste and sample his extraordinary champagne, truly an excellent value for the price.

- Meet a chocolate-maker in his workshop and learn to cook and prepare your own.
- Learn French Cuisine in Reims.

# Avenue de Champagne and Verzenay vineyards

## DAY 3

### MORNING

- Visit a family owned cellar and sample some of their best vintage Champagne.
- Stroll along the luxurious Avenue de Champagne, with XVIIIth century townhouses and learn about how champagne wine is produced.

### AFTERNOON

- Breathtaking view from the top of Verzenay lighthouse with vineyards stretching to the horizon.
- Key knowledge about what makes a wine great can be sought at the Vineyard Museum, which even has a tasting session for various champagnes.

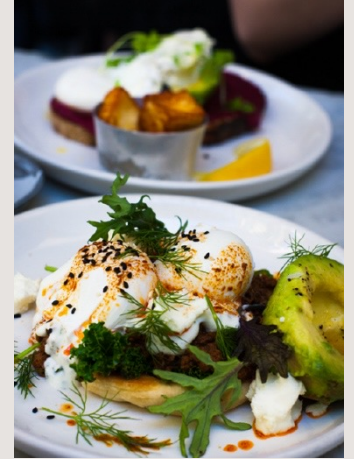
*Instead of the suggested activities in the main itinerary*
