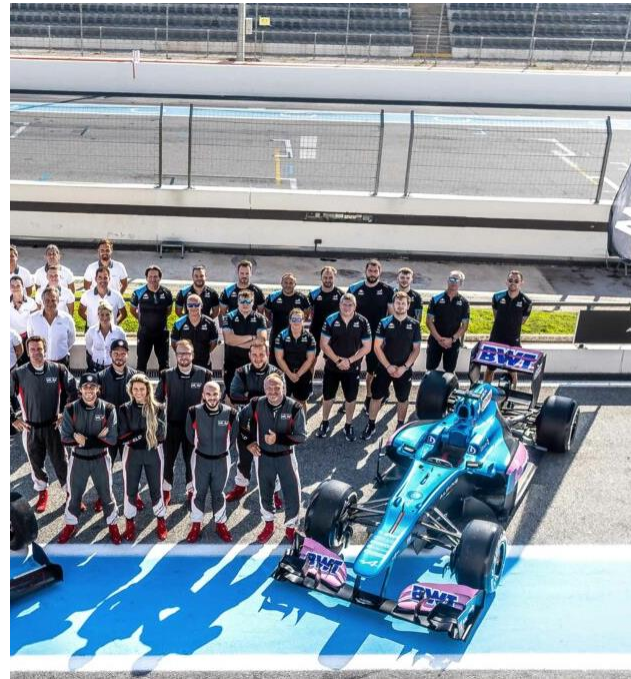

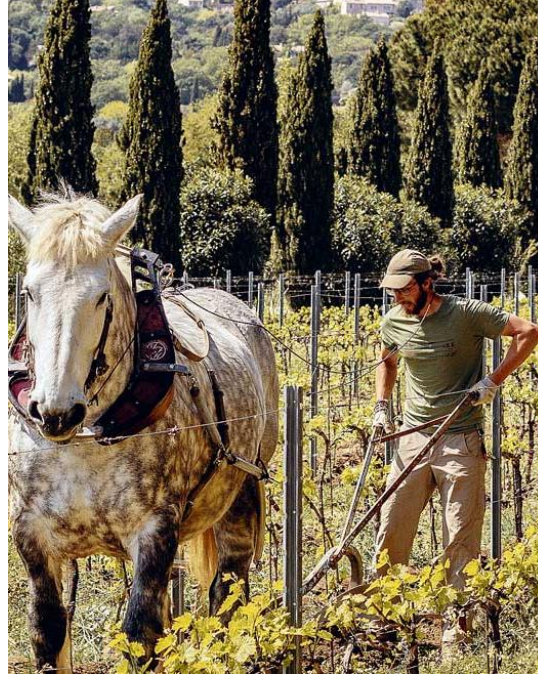


# Rolex Monte-Carlo Masters

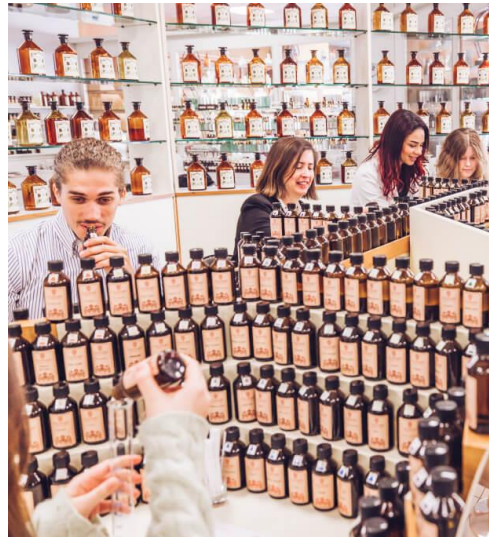
